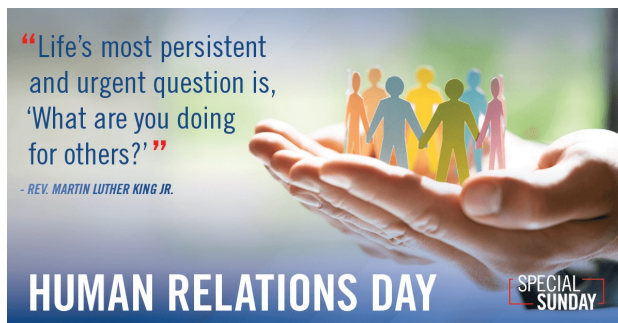
- Jan 4 - “Master Reset: The Grace-Full Reboot That Cleans Your Life”

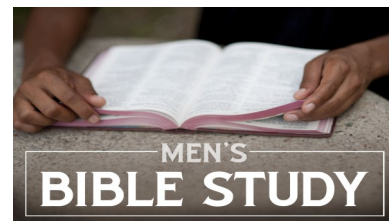
