


what it means to be part of a caring church family. We look forward to all God has in store for us together and pray His abundant blessings over each of you. Thank you for your kindness and love.




Tuesday Bible Study


Every Tuesday at 9:30 am in the Crossroads Classroom. Anyone interested is welcome and encouraged to attend!


DECORATING FOR CHRISTMAS
